

In 2017, 161 correctional facilities met the Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 89 criteria and were required to report their TB screening activities in the form of a Monthly Correctional TB Report. This annual report highlights TB screening activities in your jail and compares results to all designated Texas Health & Safety Code Chapter 89 correctional facilities.

In 2017, there were 4,212 inmate tuberculin skin tests administered and read at Willacy County Regional Detention. Of that number, 643 (16.1%) had a measurement of 10 mm or greater.

There were 184 employee tuberculin skin tests administered. Of that number, 2 (1.2%) had a measurement of 10 mm or greater.

There were four suspects and one case reported in 2017 at Willacy County Regional Detention.

All Monthly Correctional TB Reports were submitted for 2017 - 100%.
