



Texas Department of State Health Services is transitioning from the TX Rapid Test app to CDC's SimpleReport

Thank you for continuing to [submit COVID-19 test results to the Texas Department of State Health Services](#). Please note that DSHS will be sunsetting the TX Rapid Test app (<https://app.txrapidtest.org/>) currently used for reporting of BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen test results. **The TX Rapid Test app is scheduled to shut down on May 31, 2023.** The new solution for reporting COVID-19 test results from the BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen tests will be the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) SimpleReport. (<https://www.simplereport.gov>)

If your facility plans on continuing to use BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen tests, please make the switch to [SimpleReport](#) as soon as possible, and no later than May 31, 2023.

Prior to reporting COVID-19 test results through SimpleReport, **facilities are required** to complete the [COVID-19 Lab Reporting Registration Form](#). When completing the form, please ensure that you select "SimpleReport" for Question 15. Once the registration is processed, the points of contact listed will receive a confirmation email and guidance on the next steps.

What is SimpleReport?

[SimpleReport](#) is a free web-based tool that helps facilities collect and share COVID-19 test results with their state and local health departments. It is easy to set up and use and maintains HIPAA standards.

What do I need to use SimpleReport? How do I use SimpleReport?

SimpleReport requires a laptop or tablet with an internet connection, a quick registration of your testing facility and facility contact, creating patient profiles, and entering in their COVID-19 test results. SimpleReport is user friendly and easy to set up and manage. It takes less than 5 minutes to sign up and get verified. Once an account has been established, you just need to enter information about your facility and start entering in patient information.

SimpleReport offers a Bulk Upload feature. Please see links below.

Please note that you will need your facility CLIA number to sign up to use SimpleReport.
