Definitions


ILI: Influenza-Like Illness. This is an illness that resembles the flu, but has not been confirmed. **Rapid**: These tests are typically done in-house to quickly test for influenza. **PCR**: These tests are generally more precise than rapid tests and are performed at the DSHS state lab and many commercial labs to confirm a case of influenza.


Map of Regional Flu Activity



The map above depicts the previous week's reports of flu or influenza-like illness activity in each county. The legend on the bottom right of the map describes the meaning of each color.



Influenza-Like Illness Projections by Week





Positive PCR Flu Tests by Week




This chart documents the number of PCR tests that have come back positive for flu A and flu B each week throughout the region.
