


## Skills and experiences you may have developed through your degree include:

- Program Evaluator

- Program Specialist I or II
  - Assist with updating policies, procedures and audit guidelines; assist in data analysis and preparation of administrative reports, studies, and presentations
- Policy Analyst
  - Conduct research and analysis of program evaluation and epidemiologic data associated with medical, clinical, and public health work
