

Examples of Entry Level Jobs in Public Health Finance

Cash Receipts

- Process cash and other monetary instruments received at the agency. Open and sort mail, stamp remits, enter data, audit, scan, and prepare daily deposits.
- Process requests from internal customers involving refunds of revenue and deposit corrections.

Billing Branch: Accountant II

 Serve as the subject matter expert for overpayments of revenue for the DSHS laboratory – research, prepare, and maintain all aspects of the overpayments of revenue and perform account maintenance while making recommendations.

Claims: Travel

• Audit, research, resolve discrepancies, analyze and process travel claims for DSHS travelers.

Claims: Accountant II/III

- Maintain, post, and balance accounting and financial statements, records, documents, or reports.
- Assist in the preparation of financial statements, records, documents and reports.
- May specialize in work such as federal funds, property and equipment control, cost, budgeting, or bond supervising.

Interested in next steps? Consider having relevant academic, internship, or volunteer experience. Additional skills to have are data management, communication, and financial systems like CAPPS.
