

Figure 1. Texas Counties Reporting Arbovirus Activity, Week 37






Figure 3. Human Cases of West Nile Virus Reported in Texas, by MMWR Week of Onset, 2022-2024, Week 37 14 — 12 — **Number of Reported Cases** 2024 2023 -2022 **MMWR Week of Onset**
