Joy Borjes Presentation and Discussion Regarding the Postpartum Depression Strategic Plan	<ul> <li>Ms. Joy Borjes, Texas Health and Human Services</li> <li>Commission (HHSC), presented on the Postpartum</li> <li>Depression Strategic Plan for fiscal years 2021-2025 that was published in September 2020.</li> <li>Ms. Borjes provided an overview of the plan, including the five goals of the plan and the 15 strategies that were developed based on those goals.</li> <li>The 2021 update will include the status of strategy deliverables and will outline ongoing and new activities in support of the 15 strategies.</li> </ul>
5. Round-Table Discussion on Areas of Interest for Next State Health Plan	<ul> <li>The SHCC discussed possible topics to include in the next State Health Plan.</li> <li>Such topics included mental health, the behavioral health workforce, women's health, health equity, social determinants of health, coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccination, community-based organizations, dental health, and access to care.</li> </ul>

HHSC: Mr. Blanton and Ms. Ita provided an update on HHSC.</li> <li>Mr. Blanton discussed legislation related to teleservices, eligibility expansion for postpartum care, data and transparency, interstate medical licensure compact, and benchmarks for managed care.</li> <li>Ms. Ita discussed legislation related to the funding of inpatient psychiatric resources.</li> <li>Ms. Ita also discussed funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act that will be used to expand outpatient capacity, expand peer and recovery services, and enhance residential services.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Ms. Ita further discussed funding from the American Rescue Plan that is intended to maintain the expanded capacity.</li> <li>DSHS: Mr. Hajmasy provided an update on DSHS.</li> <li>Mr. Hajmasy discussed the status of COVID-19 and the state's COVID-19 vaccination efforts.</li> <li>Mr. Hajmasy also discussed legislation related to prescription drug price disclosure, the Compassionate Use Program, placenta accreta care-related protocols, the administration of vaccines by home and community services agency providers, and public health disasters and emergencies.</li> <li>Mr. Hajmasy further discussed upcoming studies related to the COVID-19 response, DSHS regions, health care system planning and response capabilities, data standardization, and COVID-19 immunization equity.</li> <li>Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board: Dr. Fu-An Lin (on behalf of Dr. Silverman) provided an update on the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.</li> <li>Dr. Lin discussed legislation related to the funding of higher education, health professions education, and the Child Mental Health Care Consortium, as well as the following programs: Family Practice Residency Program, Statewide Preceptorship Program, Autism Program, Emergency and Trauma Care Education Partnership Program, Nursing Shortage Reduction Program, Nursing Innovation Grant Program, and Minority Health Research and Education Grant Program.</li> <li>Dr. Lin also discussed legislation related to out-of-state clerkships, the Texas Epidemic Public Health Institute, the Joint Admission Medical Program, and the number of haccelaureate decrease offered by community</li> </ul>
