

Germs in your mouth produce acid that cause tooth decay. Dental sealants and varnishes help prevent and reduce the risk.

What is a Dental Sealant?



A sealant is a tooth colored protective coating painted on the chewing surface of your tooth.



Sealants protect teeth from germs that hide where your toothbrush can't reach.



Sealants help reduce cavities by 80%.





Fluoride varnish is a gel applied to your teeth that:
