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Introduction

The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) funds Tobacco Prevention and Control Coalitions (TPCC) throughout Texas. The goal of the community coalitions is to provide tobacco cessation and prevention activities. The Texas Youth Tobacco Survey (YTS) provides information to enhance the capacity to design, implement and evaluate the youth component of the TPCCs. The YTS provides data for students in grades 6-12 with respect to: prevalence of tobacco use (cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, cigars, hookah, flavored tobacco products, and e-cigarettes), exposure to environmental tobacco smoke (ETS), minors' access and enforcement, knowledge and attitudes, media and advertising, school curriculum, and tobacco use cessation.

DSHS incorporates data from the state sample into a larger database that includes historical data from previous Texas Youth Tobacco Surveys. Policy makers at the state level use this data to track trends in tobacco use so that they have up-to-date information on which to base decisions and establish prevention and cessation strategies. State level data is also used by those at the district and coalition level as a standard that they can compare their own data against – interpreting their local findings in the larger context of the state as a whole and planning appropriate action.

This report provides data for the entire state of Texas. It is divided into three major sections. The first section, titled "Prevalence Tables", provides prevalence and recency of use data for numerous tobacco products and e-cigarettes covered by the survey. In addition to providing usage information on the overall student body, this section also breaks-out the same data for specific groups within the population. The second section, titled "Miscellaneous Tables" provides data on related variables including age of first use, use on school property, perceptions of dangerousness, and ease/place of access. The final section, titled "Marginal Tables" details the number and percentage of students providing each response across all questions in the survey.
